The Humane Society International/Canada began an historic adoption process of over six hundred dogs. In September, HSI Canada rescued hundreds of dogs from the largest commercial breeding operation in Canada. As of November 24, an agreement was reached at the court, which granted custody of more than 600 dogs - including puppies born since then - to our partners in the Government of Quebec. With the adoption process being moved forward immediately by HSI/Canada, these hundreds of dogs never have to go back to living a life of misery. They will finally be on their way to loving homes of their own.

For the past two months, HSI Canada provided emergency care and shelter for the dogs as their needs were so great after being neglected for such a long period of time. Operating the shelter costs thousands of dollars per day.
